

## Nominations Due For Board Election

Quick: What is Park Glen's single most expensive activity during the year? Amazingly, it's the annual election of PGNA board members. The process of printing and mailing of ballots eats up a good portion of the budget, yet historically very few homeowners participate in the process.

Last year the PGNA board added a new, high-tech way of voting that made it easier than ever to cast a ballot: the internet. We will use the same process this year.

Homeowners will be mailed ballots with unique control numbers. The ballot will direct them to a web site where they can cast their votes after being verified by the control number.

Of course, homeowners can still vote either at the annual meeting or via mail-proxy.
