Don't be fooled by throwing away your credit card offers, old tax documents, and any other personal information in the trash. Shred them!

Cost: \$5.00 per drop off.

There is no size limitation! Shoe box or pickup truck size drop offs will be accepted and will cost only \$5.00.

The Homeowners Association is going to sponsor the first 100 families for free! Come early if you can!

Homeowners only - Business drop off's will not be accepted.

The **Crud Cruiser** mobile collection trailer will be onsite to accept unwanted household chemicals, free of charge, from citizens of Fort Worth.

The City of Fort Worth's award-winning regional collection program helps people dispose of their household chemical wastes in a responsible manner.

What's Accepted?

Acids, aerosol cans, antifreeze, batteries (all kinds, including car batteries), brake fluid, cooking oil, craft chemicals, degreasers, drain cleaner, fertilizer, fluorescent light bulbs, herbicides, household chemicals, motor oil, paints and stains, paint thinners, pest strips, pesticides, pharmaceuticals, photo chemicals, pool chemicals, oil filters, solvents, transmission fluid and varnish.

What's NOT Accepted?

Ammunition, asbestos, building materials, butane cylinders, electronics, explosives, medical waste, PCBs, propane cylinders, radioactive material, smoke detectors, TVs and tires.
