

PARK GLEN RESIDENTS.... Please take the time to read this information that concerns the children of the Park Glen Community..... And possibly cause a decline to the value of your property.

The Keller Independent School District ("KISD") is proposing to change the high school boundaries that WILL HAVE A NEGATIVE EFFECT on the community of Park Glen.

Currently, the students attending KISD schools in the Park Glen community attend Central High School. There are several proposed high school boundary maps that have the KISD students in Park Glen being divided between Central and Fossil Ridge High School. All of the maps show the area west of the Creek and east of Beach Street attending Fossil Ridge HS. Two of the maps show the area west of Park Vista and east of Beach Street attending Fossil Ridge HS. Another map shows **EVERY** Park Glen residence currently zoned for Central HS being rezoned to Fossil Ridge HS. None of the proposed boundary maps keeps the all of the KISD students of the Park Glen community attending Central HS.

The students affected by these boundary changes will have to leave the Central HS (and all their friends they have had through the school years), and will be rezoned to Fossil Ridge HS. This change will take effect in 2009. So, the Park Glen students will attend 5th through 8th grade together, then the kids affected by the boundary change will have to start 9th grade at Fossil Ridge HS, and will be forced to make new friends at a critical time in their education. In addition, the majority of the students involved in the sports and extra curricular activities at Parkwood Hill Intermediate and Hillwood Middle schools are forming allegiances to Central HS. Rezoning some of these kids to Fossil Ridge HS could cause issues for these rezoned students due to school rivalries.

This rezoning could also possibly cause a decline to your property value. Who will want to buy a home in a "community neighborhood" where the students in KISD are split up attending different high schools? This does not promote the community integrity...it only causes more division in the neighborhood.

Several of the phases in Park Glen have been rezoned several times by KISD at the elementary, intermediate, middle and HS levels in the past few years. This will make the 6th time that the Hills of Park Glen have been rezoned. It is time to let KISD know that we are a community and we DO NOT want our students rezoned AGAIN.
